# Yale-New Haven Children's Hospital Child Psychiatric Inpatient Service

The Child Psychiatric Inpatient Service at Yale-New Haven Children's Hospital is a 15-bed inpatient unit for children ages 4-14. We are an acute care unit with an average length of stay of 28 days. Our children are admitted with various diagnoses including depression, suicidal ideation, psychosis, post-traumatic stress disorder, and mood disorders.

Our nurses actively participate in a number of Department-specific and Unit-Based Committees, which also offer representation from other disciplines including MD, Social Work, Therapeutic Recreation, School Staff, RNs and Milieu Counselors, and BAs.
